PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

Upon full hearing, after notice, held herein June 1, 2 and 3, 1964, and in conformity with Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law filed herein, and upon all proceedings herein, it is now by the Court

ORDERED:

1. That the Defendants, L. O. Davis, Jr., as Sheriff of St. Johns County, Florida; Virgil Stuart, as Chief of Police of the City of St. Augustine, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida, and Joseph A. Shelley, as Mayor of the City of St. Augustine, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida, their agents, servants, employees and any and all persons acting under their authority or in concert with them, are enjoined and restrained, until the further Order of this Court, from enforcing, or attempting to enforce, directly or indirectly, the orders orally promulgated by them on Thursday, May 28, 1964, and Friday,



May 29, 1964, to the Plaintiff, Andrew Young, and others of his class, prohibiting Andrew Young and other Negroes or persons associated with them from peaceful and orderly demonstrations by marching in and about the City of St. Augustine, Florida, and its public streets, sidewalks and parks, at any hour in the night time.

2. Said persons are further enjoined and restrained, until the further Order of this Court, from promulgating, issuing or attempting to enforce orders of a like or similar tenor and effect.

3. This Preliminary Injunction shall issue instanter and be served by the United States Marshal for this District immediately; provided it shall have no further force and effect beyond three days from the date hereof unless the Plaintiff, within three days from the date hereof, files herein his injunction bond, conditioned in usual form, to be taken before and approved by the Clerk of this Court.

DONE AND ORDERED at Jacksonville, Florida, within said District, this June 9, 1964.
